1. Complete the application and send with payment to:
Robin Robertson, Clerk at 9212 Woerner Road, Onsted, MI 49265. Make checks payable to Rome Township.
2. The Clerk will send the Permit to the Applicant when payment is received. Work shall not begin until the Permit is received by the Applicant. All installations shall be in conformance with the Michigan Residential and National Electric codes. No work shall be concealed until inspected.
3. When work is complete and ready for inspection, contact the Electrical Inspector (noted above) for inspection.

A permit will be cancelled when no inspections are requested and conducted within six months of the date of issuance or the date of a previous inspection. Cancelled permits cannot be reinstated, and fees are not refundable.
