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VIII. INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION

GENERAL: Electrical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with the Township. All installations shall be in conformance with the Township Electrical Code. No work shall be concealed until inspected.

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit will be cancelled when no inspections are requested and conducted within six months of the date of issuance or the date of a previous inspection. Cancelled permits cannot be reinstated.
