There is a concern if it doesn't pass with a vote the township may lose the .5 mills. The reason for the increase is to improve the roads. Further information will be reviewed. Randy Parkhurst submitted a bid for a 2-year cemetery maintenance contract. Leo made a motion to accept the maintenance bid, 2nd by Jeremiah. All in Favor, Motion Carried. Road Commission contracts were reviewed. After discussion, the following contracts were approved via motions as stated: Leo made a motion, 2nd by Roxann to approve Contract numbers 4457,4459,4461,4462,4511. All in favor, Motion Carried. Jeremiah made a motion to approve Contract number 4460, 2nd by Leo, all in favor, Motion Carried. Leo made a Motion to transfer \$50,000.00 from the General Fund to the Road Fund to meet the financial need of the approved contracts. 2nd by Roxann, all in favor, Motion Carried. Discussion regarding the Project Phoenix was brought to the table. Rome Twp Board is not in favor of Lenawee County investing the full ARPA funds payment they received into a project that is not easily available to all Lenawee County residents. A Resolution to express the Board's opposition by writing a letter to the County Clerk was put before the Board by a Motion by Leo, 2nd by Roxann.
